sonal dedication and sacrifices required to attain them. Carl believed in his dream and made it happen.


The trip was very emotional and packed with inspirational impacts, which was evidenced by the turn out and feedback received during this trip.

DAY ONE - Ron & Tom, along with Ron's Mother, a pair of Ron's brothers, and the retired Juvenile Judge, "Babe" Thomas, were on hand as Ron delivered a very testimonial message to the 94 juveniles that were held in custody at the same center where Ron was once held as a juvenile. The YOH foundation provided all of the youth there with a complimentary copy of "Bouncing Back...Living Life the right way", authored by Mr. Brashear himself. Ron personally autographed the books to each of the youth with the words "HAVE THE COURAGE TO CHANGE." After the speech concluded, several youth lined up to personally meet and speak with Mr. Brashear and let him know how much it meant to them by having him come to the facility and share his story in an effort to inspire them to GROW through it instead of just GO through it! Over a dozen youth came forward to talk personally with Ron and Tom regarding their desire to change their

ways once they exit the facility and return to the community.

DAY TWO - Ron & Tom spoke to a crowd at the Elizabethtown Pritchard Center. The bulk of the crowd, on this day, were adults and parents. Tom shared the history and vision of the YOH foundation and Ron spoke to the audience about the importance of the role that the parents and adults play in supporting our youth that feel, at times, like they can't move forward. The theme was titled, "Today's Youth - A Paralyzed Generation". The YOH team raffled off copies of the book "Bouncing Back" as well as some GET YOH JUMP ON LIFE T-shirts. Ron challenged the youth and adults in the crowd to make a personal commitment to a better tomorrow by signing the YOH Banner. There was tremendous response to the request, including the Mayor of Elizabethtown, Mayor David Willmoth, Sr. signing the banner as well. This was a very uplifting and in-

DAY THREE – Ron Brashear was the guest speaker for Youth Day at the First Baptist Church (FBC) of Elizabethtown. Words can hardly express what transpired on this occasion. After sitting through a phenomenal performance by the Youth of FBC, Mr. Brashear was introduced and called to the podium. The Church was packed to its 300+ capacity and the youth, as well as adults, were treated to an ear full of a moving and emotional testimony from Ron Brashear. He delivered a theme message titled "Keeping God's Hands on the Wheel". Ron shared with the youth about how he <u>Captured His Monsters</u>, which were outlined as poor choices; didn't want to pay the price for success, looking for a quick fix and how to make a fast dollar, etc. The Church was very receptive of Ron's delivery and his message!

It was an amazing testimony that energized the capacity crowd and approximately five youth turned their life over to Christ and joined Church immediately following Mr. Brashear's speech. It was a tremendous blessing to have been on hand to witness this event!


